Editorial Note

Another change in the editorship of the Philippine Sociological Review has taken place with the assignment of Mr. Salvador Parco as Acting Chairman of the Department of Sociology and Anthropology at the Ateneo University. The new editors wish to make it known that they will continue along the main task pursued by the previous editors of fostering the growth of social science and of increasing the understanding of Philippine society and culture. In carrying out this task, they will welcome the support and assistance of every reader of the Review and every member of the Philippine Sociological Society.

Increased participation from our readers and members here and abroad in the improvement of the Review through the submission of articles, comments and suggestions on the articles published, news items on the activities of social scientists which are pertinent to the scientific study of social life in the Philippines as well as the solicitation of financial support for the Review's continuing and up-to-date publication is hoped for.

We take this opportunity to reiterate the announcement of the national conference of the Philippine Sociological Society, Inc. on "Research and Institutional Planning" which will be held at the National Science Development Board Pavilion in Manila on May 12-15, 1966. In this national convention, thirty social scientists and other resource persons will participate. The papers delivered at this national convention will be published in a coming issue of the Review. suing issues, more articles for publication are needed. We earnestly seek the cooperation of the personnel of varied public and private agencies and institutions along this line.

In submitting manuscripts make sure that they are submitted in double-spaced typescript with liberal margins. Galley proofs will not be sent to the authors unless explicitly requested.

It is understood that articles and comments in the Review do not represent the views of either the Philippine Sociological Society or of the editors. The editors are responsible only for the selection and acceptance of material submitted. Responsibility for opinions expressed in the articles and comments contained in them rests solely with individual authors.

Due to numerous requests for copies of articles published in past issues of the Review (which are now unfortunately out-of-print), arrangements to reprint them will be made. Listing of on-going social researches and indexing of the Review will be published periodically.

The special grant from the Asia Foundation which has greatly helped in updating the publication of the Review expires in May, 1966. Because of this, efforts will have to be exerted in the solicitation of ads and/or increasing the number of individual or institutional members and subscribers.

We are also publishing a financial report of the Philippine Sociological Society for the year 1965 and a listing of renewed members for 1966.
