The 1956 Board of Directors invested part of the funds of the Philippine Statistical Association for the purchase of five Government Rehabilitation and Development Bonds due in 1959, totalling five thousand pesos.

The Association held its Annual Meeting last December for the election of nine Members to serve during the year 1957 The Directors held their first meeting last January and elected in accordance with law, the Officers for the current year.

Dr. Meredith B. Givens, one of our Founding Members, is now Executive Director of the Interdepartmental Committee on Low Incomes, of the State of New York. In 1951 he inspired and labored effectively for the organization of the Philippine Statistical Association. Later he was the UN Principal Statistical Advisor of the Statistical Center, University of the Philippines.
